Various Entry Points

Level 1: Finished compulsory education (Initial Assessment Tests may apply)

Level 2: Finished compulsory education (Initial Assessment Tests may apply)

Level 3: 2 subjects at Sec/O level (grade 1-5)/SSC&P level 3 **OR** 1 subject at Sec/O Level (grade 1-5) **plus** SSC&P Global Certification at level 2 **OR** MCAST Foundation Certificate*

Level 4: Minimum of 3 subjects at SEC/O level (grade 1-5)/SSC&P level 3 (**this applies only for this year due to Covid-19**) **OR** MCAST Diploma level 3*

Level 5/6: 2 A-Level passes and 2 I-Level passes **OR** MCAST Advanced Diploma level 4*

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Special Instructions 2020/1



Fact #1

Level 1/2: Applicants who have finished compulsory education will be accepted to MCAST level 1 or level 2 study programmes, following Initial Assessment Tests.

Fact #2

Level 3/4: Applicants with SSC&P* level 3 subjects based on their performance from Year 7-Year 10 or with SEC Level 3 subjects based on the predictive assessment as performed by MATSEC, will be accepted either to MCAST Level 3 or to Level 4 study programmes, depending on specific entry requirements. In cases where a grade higher than 5/C at level 3 is required, the student will be deemed eligible if his/her predictive results by MATSEC are issued at MQF level 3.

Fact #3

Level 6: Students studying at Matriculation level will be provisionally accepted to MCAST Level 6 programmes according to the specific entry requirements of the degree programme applied for.

Fact #4

Level 6: Students failing to obtain the necessary requirements following the resit sessions in December, will be offered an undergraduate diploma after successfully completing all units of their first year of studies (*this applies for A level and Intermediate sessions only*). Students will be able to continue their studies at second year as regular students in the Level 5/6 course if they successfully complete all units (60 ECTS) during the first year and having successfully obtained a minimum of 48 MCAST admission points during their MATSEC Exams as per MCAST prospectus.
